This school year, all ICS West students will benefit from participating in *Eatiquette*, a school lunch program implemented in select Philadelphia schools that uses fresh healthy food, family style dining, and other principles to improve the lives of children.

The partnership aims to educate students on healthy eating habits by exposing them to a range of nutritious meals prepared on premises.

BILINGUAL PROGRAM AT ICS WEST

Our school has a dual language program in Kindergarten and 1st Grade. In these grades, students receive 50 percent of their instruction (Language Arts, Social Studies, Math) in Spanish, and the other 50 percent in English (Language Arts, Science).

In 2nd and 3rd Grades, students receive the majority of their instruction in English, including Reading, Math, Science and Social Studies, from their regular classroom teacher, and benefit from a daily Spanish class taught following the FLES (Foreign Language for Elementary Schools) framework.
